D1: Arrival Taipei (X/X/X)

Taoyuan Airport → Taipei Hotel
 ^Taipei Hotel A: Taipei Wonstar Ximen, Taipei Ferry or similar/ Hotel B: Riverview, New Continental, Cosmos or similar

D2: Taipei~ Yilan (B/X/D)

Taipei~CKS Memorial Hall: Was erected in honour and memory of Generalissimo Chiang Kai-shek, the former President of the Republic of China, and was opened in 1980 as part of a national park and gathering area.

Jiufen's Old Street: Little Shanghai of Taiwan due to be the center of gold mining. Its foggy weather providing a romantic atmosphere.

Yilan~Jimmy Park + Diu Diu Dang Forest: Jimmy is a famous book creator in Taiwan, whose playful style presents deep and sobering stories. Diu Diu Dang Forest park is a special cycads forest, the park is composed of ballads and trees. It's a modern concept of forest city.

Luodong Forestry Culture Garden: It preserves decades of historical and cultural meaning. Old facilities are now used as exhibition rooms and education centers.

D3: Yilan~Hualien~Taitung (B/L/D)

Yilan~Friendly Garden (Vegetables & Fruit DIY): Here one can give planting and learn about composting, natural insect and pest control, and everything else that goes into planting, nurturing, protecting, and harvesting the farm's organically grown produce.

Aboriginal Culture - Hualien~Suhua Highway

Taroko National Park (Arch of Toroko, Eternal Spring Shrine): With its marbles-walled canyons, lush vegetation and mountainous landscape, Taroko really puts the Formosa (beautiful) in Ilya Formosa.

East Rift Valley: A valley extending from Hualien to Taitung. It conceals a host of aboriginal cultures and natural landscapes.

Guangfu Sugar Factory: Attraction as tourism factory and recreation area, which has provides guide tours, creative workshops at cultural park,....etc.

Tropic of Cancer: The Tropic of Cancer is located at 23.5 degrees north latitude. Every year at noon during the summer solstice, the sun shines right into the slits on the Tropic of Cancer. At this time, tourists can experience the phenomenon of shadowlessness under the sun

Taitung~Jihhien Hot Spring (wear swimsuit): Some Japanese style bathhouses and outdoor hot spring pools that are built during the Japanese colonial period.

Kaohsiung~Buddha Museum (Change to Foguangshan on Tue): The largest religious sacred ground for Buddhism in Taiwan.

The Pier-2 Art Center: The whole area consisted of old warehouses converted into art galleries, art installations, boutiques, bookstores and cafes.

Banana Pier: The Banana Pier at Fisherman's Wharf used to be a warehouse for storing bananas. Hence, the pier called "Banana Pier".

第二天: 臺北~宜蘭 (早/X/晚)

臺北~中正紀念堂: 為紀念已故前中華民國總統蔣中正而興建的建築, 位於台北市, 也是眾多紀念總統建築中規模最大者。

九份山城: 九份老街保留著日本舊時生活風貌, 紅燈籠, 窄巷道, 青石階, 斑駁的木質建築等, 風格獨特, 因《悲情城市》和《千與千尋》聲名遠播。

宜蘭~幾米公園: 全台第一座幾米主題廣場, 現場的裝置藝術全取自知名繪本作家[幾米]的作品, 繪本[向左走, 向右走]中的男女主角往各自方向走去的場景, 在廣場上原貌重現。

丟丟當森林: 坐落於宜蘭火車站對面, [丟丟當公園]是火車民謠與綠色森林所組成, 具有現代感設計理念的森林公園。

羅東林業文化園區: 有著森林資源豐富並結合了休閒, 教育, 文化等多功能的觀摩導覽, 成為最佳休閒旅遊的觀光景點。

高雄~佛陀紀念館(周二改佛光山): 星云大師為供奉佛牙舍利所建的紀念館。歷經 9 年完工, 現除了主體建築本館外, 更有所謂“前有八塔, 後有大佛, 南有靈山, 北有祇園”的雄偉格局。

駁二文創園區: 原為港口廠庫, 後改造成藝術特區, 且保留了斑駁的鐵門與裸露的水泥牆。

香蕉碼頭: 原名為香蕉棚, 屹立于高雄港近半世紀, 現為高雄市歷史建築之一。
