ITINERARY

DAY 1 : DANANG ARRIVAL – HUE (No Meals)

Upon arrival at Danang Airport, you will be warmly welcomed by our local guide and transfer further North to Hue - the former Imperial City of the last dynasty of Vietnam. Have a short stop on top of the pass – once regarded as the prime mountain pass on the North - South national road. Arrival Hue, check in the hotel Overnight at hotel in Hue.

DAY 2 : HUE - DANANG – HOI AN (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

Morning you will meet with our guide and start the day to explore the Imperial City of Hue. The Hue Citadel is situated on the Northern bank of the Perfume River and built by Emperor Gia Long it was designed for the exclusive use of the Emperor and his household. The Citadel is a square 2 km wall encompassing 3 walled enclosures; the Citadel, Kinh Thanh Hue, the Yellow Imperial city, Hoang Thanh and in the centre the Forbidden Purple city Tu Cam Thanh where the Emperor lived. The Hue royal complex has been officially recognized by the UNESCO as a World Heritage Site Then enjoy a scenic boat trip on the Perfume River to visit the Thien Mu Pagoda (Heavenly Lady pagoda), one of the oldest ancient architectural structures for religious worship in Hue. Situated 4 km upstream on the banks of the Perfume River, it is an active Buddhist monastery with its origins dating back to 1601. Later, visit Dong Ba Market for shopping. Lunch at local restaurant Afternoon, we start the spectacular drive over Hai Van Pass to Danang with a whole view of Pacific Ocean and famous Lang Co fishing village. Continuing to the charming historic city of Hoi An which lies on the banks of the Thu Bon River. Hoi an was one of the major trading centres of Southeast Asia in the 16th century and was declared a World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1999. Dinner at the local restaurant and Overnight at hotel in Hoi An

DAY 3 : COCONUT VILLAGE – HOI AN ANCIENT TOWN (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Cam Thanh water coconut village. Learn about the daily life of Vietnamese fishermen, their families and their community. Board on boat and commence cruising on the Cua Dai River. Join in local fisherman on the river and experience on round net or cast net. Learn how to paddle the Vietnamese unique bamboo basket boat. Explore the now tranquil coconut-palm flanked waterways of a past war and hear of the extreme conditions endured by soldiers of both sides. Lunch at the local restaurant. Afternoon, enjoy the walking tour to discover Hoi An ancient town, which was originally a Cham seaport but has been influenced down centuries by a myriad of traders from various cultures. There are plenty to see in this tranquil and delightful town, some of which are the famous Japanese Covered Bridges, the Pottery Museum, the 200 years old Tam Ky House, the Chua Ong Pagoda and the bustling market. We visit these sights on an exciting walking tour past many low tiled houses scattered along the small streets and assembly halls which reflect the town's multi-cultural past. Afterward, free at leisure for shopping or walking around Hoi An Ancient town for shopping local product. Dinner at the local restaurant. Transfer to Danang hotel for check-in.

DAY 4 : DANANG – BANA HILLS (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)

After breakfast, our guide will pick you up and start to visit Ba Na Hills - King Mountain, also known as the second Da Lat/ Sapa in Central. The beautiful weather here is always cool. You will admire the high by the most modern cable car system in Southeast Asia. You will visit Dream Stream Cable Car Station. After finishing the first cable car, you will visit France wine cellar, exploring the golden bridge (Winding its way around a 150-meter course lined with flowers, a golden bridge shimmers against the Ba Na Hills, supported by a pair of giant hands.). Linh Ung pagoda. You will see the panorama of Danang City. Visit and play game at the Fantasy Park. Afternoon, explore King Peak at an altitude 1.487m, you can see panorama view of the Hana Hills and Quang Nam - Da Nang on high. On the top of mountain have Linh Tu Pagoda that is a special temple construction. Back to the cabin down the mountain and shopping at Han market. Dinner at the local restaurant. Overnight at hotel in Danang.

DAY 5 : HOI AN – DANANG DEPARTURE (Breakfast)

Breakfast at hotel and free at leisure until transfer to Da Nang International airport for flight back home. End of services!
